



# COMMUNICATION STRATEGIES



## COMPASS

Every fortnight, Forrie Files will be posted on Compass to share major events taking place at school.

Urgent updates that may take place through the school week will be posted on Compass.

Teachers will post messages on Compass to inform parents/carers of upcoming classroom events.

Each week, teachers will post a brief message on Compass outlining what major learning topics and intentions will be taught in classrooms.

## WEBSITE

The school website ([firstinforrestfield.wa.edu.au](http://firstinforrestfield.wa.edu.au)) provides information about the school (e.g. school policies, term planners, booklists).

## SOCIAL MEDIA

Parents/carers will receive messages on the school's Facebook page about whole school events.

## PROGRESS & REPORTS

Parents/carers will have an opportunity to meet with teachers late in Term 1 to check how their child has settled into class and are progressing with their learning.

Student reports will be sent home at the end of Semester 1 and Semester 2 detailing the achievement and progress of students.

## SUPPORT

Teachers will meet with parents/carers of students who require support or extension, and who are on Documented Plans, at least once per term to provide updates on their child's progress in their learning. Documented Plans will also be sent home each term to be reviewed, signed and returned to school.

The school's Psychologist will meet with parents/carers at the start and end of each term of those students that they oversee to keep them informed how their academic, behaviour and/or emotional wellbeing is being supported at school.
